Independent Custody Visitors (ICVs) make unannounced visits to police stations to check that people detained there are being properly looked after. They are unpaid volunteers and completely independent of the police service.

They can enter custody suites in pairs, unannounced, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year and speak to detainees and check on their welfare.

ICVs are recruited by the Police and Crime Commissioner for West Yorkshire.
